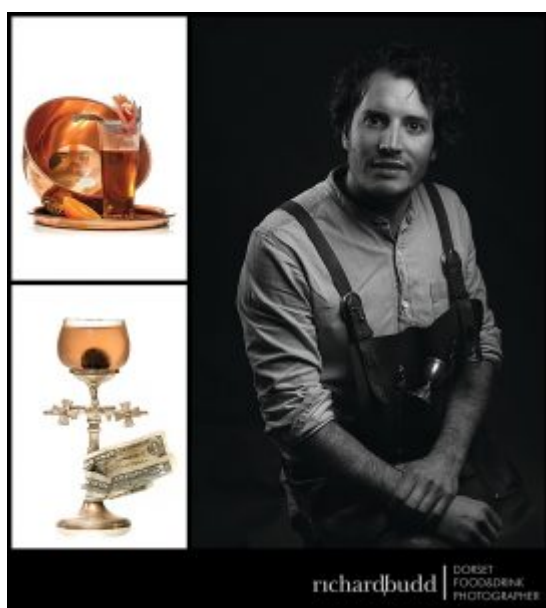


Dorset Moonshine Book Launch... Dorset's best bartenders, bars and drinks showcased in new book, Dorset Moonshine
